That, in respect of this programme:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) the outcome recommended by the visitors (including the conditions set out in their report) be accepted, but subject to the variation set out below; and ii) the condition on standard 5.10 is removed from the visitors report
Reasons
<p>Having considered the observations provided by the education provider the Panel noted that conditions will always be communicated to an Education Provider through the Visitors' report and not through a meeting at the visit itself.</p> <p>In relation to the condition against standard 5.10, the Panel was satisfied that the observation provided by the education provider provided sufficient evidence to demonstrate that there is regular and effective communication between the education provider and the practice placement provider. Therefore the Panel were satisfied that the report should be varied to remove this condition from the Visitors' report.</p> <p>The Panel was satisfied that the conditions in the Visitors' report must be met before the programme can be approved or before the ongoing approval of the</p>

programme can be confirmed.
