<p>The Panel did not agree with the conclusion reached by the visitors through the annual monitoring audit process that a visit was required to review the issues raised.</p> <p>The Panel was satisfied the programme continues to meet the relevant education standards and noted that the annual monitoring audit report did not provide sufficient reasons to require an approval visit to be undertaken. In coming to a decision the Panel considered</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the visitor's recommendation contained in the report • the recommendation of the additional visitor • the observations provided by the education provider • the validation body's statement of support <p>In consideration of the above, the Panel reached a decision to not visit the programme and grant ongoing approval based on</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the purpose of the annual monitoring process being to assess declared changes to the programme • the disproportionality of requiring a visit due to the nature of the additional

- evidence required and which was outlined in the visitor's report
- the documentation presented to the panel.
