Operations Report to Finance & Resources Committee, 20 November 2007

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Summary

This paper provides an update from the UK and International Registration Departments for the period 1 August 2007 to 30 September 2007.

1) Operational Performance

a) Telephone Calls

i) UK Department - During the period from 1 August 2007 to 30 September 2007 the team received a total of 29,403 telephone calls which is 19,379 more than the same period two years ago. 18,564 calls were answered which was 10,396 more than when compared to the same period two years ago. This 293% increase in the volume of telephone calls received has resulted in the department achieving a 227% increase in the number of telephone calls answered. This dramatic increase in the number of telephone calls has been driven by an increased understanding by registrants and employers of the importance of completing and returning renewals forms within the specified timescales. The recent disruption in the postal service has also had a direct affect on the number of telephone calls received.

ii) International Department - During the period from 1 August 2007 to 30 September 2007 the team received a total of 2498 telephone calls, 88% of which were answered. The programme of multi-skilling Registration Advisors enabled those working in the International Department to assist their colleagues within the UK Department.

b) Application Processing

i) UK Department - A total of 2794 new applications were received during this period and 2773 individuals were registered. Applications took on average eight working days to process which exceeds our target of ten working days.

Applications for readmission were taking an average of seven working days to process.

ii) International Department - A total of 296 new international applications were received in this period and 286 individuals were registered.

c) Emails

i) UK Department - The team received approximately 60/80 emails per day and responded to these within 48 of hours of receipt.

ii) International Department - The team received approximately 20/30 emails per day and responded to these within 48 hours of receipt.

Registration Renewal

At the start of June, all registered paramedics and orthoptists were invited to renew their registration for the next two-year cycle. Registrants were given until 31 August 2007 to renew their registration for the 2007/09 registration period. Of the number originally invited to renew registration, 6% of paramedics and 7% of orthoptists lapsed from the Register This compares favourably with 2005 when 13.7% of paramedics and 12.3% of orthoptists lapsed.

At the start of July, all registered prosthetists and orthotists, clinical scientists, speech and language therapists were invited to renew their registration for the next two-year cycle. Registrants were given until 30 September to renew their registration for the 2007/09 registration period. Of the number originally invited to renew registration, 11.3% of prosthetists and orthotists, 7.4% of clinical scientists and 7.6%, speech and language therapists lapsed from the Register. Again, this compares favourably with 2005.

At the start of August 28,866 occupational therapists and in September 22,588 biomedical scientists were invited to renew their registration. Due to the exceptional circumstances caused by the postal disruption to those renewing their registration, it was agreed to allow an additional 'grace period' for renewal applications to be received. Occupational therapists have until 30 November 2007 and biomedical scientists the 17 December 2007 to renew their registration.

2) Employee Resource

Both teams are currently operating within their budgeted headcount with operational effectiveness improving. Cross training has continued for Registration Advisors within the International team, who are assisting UK colleagues during their very busy period and learning whilst they are doing it.

During the period Natalie Fraser was recruited as a Registration Advisor.

3) Improvements/Developments

An online authentication service is now available for orthoptists. This new service delivery channel allows registrants to access their contact details at any time in order to make sure the HPC always has the correct contact information about them. Registrants will also be able set up a direct debit instruction online. The online service will be rolled out to each profession individually once the profession has been through the current renewal cycle.

4) Temporary Registration for Visiting EEA Health Professionals

Procedures and processes are in place to accept applications for temporary registration under Directive 2005/36/EC (Professional Qualifications Directive) which will come into force on 20 October 2007.

Quality – Greg Ross-Sampson

Communication with Stakeholders

Projects

The department has spent a lot of time over the last two months focusing on the projects outlined in the work plan for 2007-08.

Of the 14 projects, one has been completed and one has been put on hold. The remaining 12 projects are ongoing. Some are ahead of their schedule, whilst others are slightly behind. The prioritisation of individual projects has been revisited since April 2007 to account for changes in resources (staffing and time) and the workflow of the operational processes.

Presentations to Education Providers

The department is in the middle of their series of annual presentations to education providers. The presentation this year updates education providers on the wider work of the HPC (e.g. implications of the White Paper, publication of disability guidance, on boarding of new professions, PLG work on the review of the standards of education and training) as well as feeding back findings from the approval and monitoring processes from 2006-07.

Partners

The department is working with the Partner Manager to recruit new occupational therapist (clinicians); dietitian and dramatherapist visitors. Interviews are planned for new dramatherapist visitors in early December and advertisements are due to be placed for occupational therapist and dietitian visitors shortly.

Employees

Unfortunately, Barry Molloy (Education Administrator) resigned and is due to leave the Department at the end of November 2007. Two temporary administrators will be joining the department in mid November 2007 to cover this vacancy, and another created due to a period of maternity leave.

The Department is interviewing for two Education Officers in mid November 2007 to fill the current vacancies.
