Executive Summary and Recommendations – Decision Making

Introduction

Following the conclusion of a full hearing of a panel of the Conduct and Competence Committee, Health Committee or the Investigating Committee when considering whether an entry to the register has been incorrectly made or fraudulently procured, panels are asked to announce their decision, their reason for making it and any sanctions they deem necessary and the reasons for that sanction. Panels are also asked to advise the registrant of their right to appeal. The attached example for decision making has been adopted by the Conduct and Competence Committee.
