Equality and Diversity Scheme Demographic Data Reports

Executive summary and recommendations

Introduction

The Fitness to Practise Department has been gathering equality and diversity data from registrants and complainants since 1 April 2007. In line with HPC's equality and diversity scheme, approved by Council in December 2007, this paper provides the fitness to practise committees with an update of the data collected in the first year from registrants and complainants.

Equality and diversity monitoring forms have been sent to all complainants where they are a member of the public and to all registrants who have been the subject of a complaint. The information that is requested is:

- gender;
- age;
- sexual orientation;
- disability;
- religion; and
- Race/ethnicity.

The information is sent to HPC voluntarily and the forms are returned anonymously. Once the data is received, it is logged on a spreadsheet which is not linked to our fitness to practise database. To encourage responses, a stamped address envelope is provided with the form. We may receive further responses in due course from forms that have been sent more recently.

108 complaints were received from members of the public between April 2007 and March 2008. We have received responses from 45 complainants to date which is a response rate of 41.6%. Details of the responses are attached to this report.

All registrants who have been subject to a fitness to practise allegation were sent a monitoring form at the time they were notified of an allegation and provided with an opportunity to respond. 336 registrants were notified of allegations between April 2007 and March 2008. To date we have received 56 responses which is a response rate of 16.6%. Details of the responses are attached.

As we have received a low response, particularly from registrants, we would recommend to the committees that a further one year period of data collection is undertaken before we analyse the data fully. The scheme provides that the data will be analysed to help us understand how our processes are working and potentially reveal further steps we could take to mitigate or eliminate any adverse impact. However, with the limited data we currently have, this is not yet possible.

To increase the response rate from registrants, from April 2008, monitoring forms will be sent at a later stage in the process. When registrants are notified of an allegation, there is often a lot of documentation provided to them. It is also a very stressful time for registrants and they may not wish complete the monitoring form or consider this their priority when providing a full response to the allegation. We will therefore request the information when the registrant is notified of the date of the panel which will consider whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegation that has been made.

In addition, it should be noted that although information collected through the fitness to practise process can be analysed separately, it could have greater value in the future if it could be compared against a wider snapshot of the demographic data of the Register as a whole. This analysis would enable HPC to identify any areas where particular groups appeared to be disproportionately affected by fitness to practise processes, and enable HPC to plan any action needed as a result. Collecting this additional data would entail significant resources, and would need careful consideration, justification and planning.

Decision

The forum is asked to recommend that the committees approve the following resolution:

- 1. Data is collected from registrants and complainants for a further one year and;
- 2. a report provided to the committees in April 2009.
