Update on Registration since 09/07/2003

HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL

Applications:

The first applications where received prior to July 9th 2003:

- UK Dietician all documentation was complete and correct
- <u>GRANDPARENTING Chiropodist</u> all documentation was complete and correct
- <u>INTERNATIONAL Finnish Physiotherapist</u> incomplete form, no health or character reference, documents had not been translated and had used an old clinical reference form!

Pass Lists have been received from 76 of 146 approved programmes

Approximately 150 applications pending processing in UK

New applications are taking a long time to input into the new system as there is more complexity to the information we're holding about an applicant before they become registered. In particular the Grandparenting and International applicants are lengthy due to the new information being captured on training institution, professional body/organisation membership and details of professional indemnity insurance.

Telephone Calls:

Total # of Calls on 9/7/03 = 1207 The International and UK teams answered 86% of all calls that day!

Total # of Calls since 9/7/03 = 3445

The International and UK teams have answered on average nearly 90% of all calls in the past 4 days of operations

Call profiles:

UK calls have come mainly from enquiries regarding the new forms – particular concern is the Health Reference

International calls have come mainly from Chiropodists requesting an application form for registration via Grandparenting or International applicants enquiring about an existing application
